## 15th December 2024 is the Third Sunday of Advent

Known as Gaudete Sunday, after the first word of the entrance antiphon, which is 'Rejoice in the Lord always, and again I say, rejoice. Indeed, the Lord is near.' Because we are now over halfway through Advent, as sign of softening our penitential rigours, the vestments are rose rather than violet. In the first reading the prophet Zephaniah tells the people of Jerusalem that the presence of the Lord will bring them joy. In the Gospel from Saint Luke, we hear the preaching of John the Baptist. He exhorts the people to repent from their sins, and he also tells them that the Lord is on His way. The Lord will grant His people the Holy Spirit, and will also judge them according to their deeds.

## This Sunday

There is a retiring collection for Christmas flowers, originally scheduled for last week. Collectors, please take this as your invitation to stand with the baskets at both doors at the end of Mass. <u>This Saturday</u> evening the Confirmation candidates are gathering before the 6pm Vigil Mass and will be enrolled in the Confirmation Programme during the Mass.

## **Liturgical Notes**

There are no feasts this week apart from the memorial, on Saturday, of Saint Peter Canisius (1521 -1597). He was a Dutchman and a Jesuit, who devoted his life to preaching and teaching in Germany, where he drew many souls back to the Catholic Church and away from Protestantism. He wrote three books of Catechism to explain the faith. He also wrote extensively on Our Lady and he is the one who was responsible for the words 'Holy Mary, Mother of God, pray for us sinners' being included in the Hail Mary.
